DESCRIPTION

M Parkway is a vibrant high quality ‘edge of town’, supermarket anchored, community shopping centre at the heart of Coulby Newham. Constructed in 1985 the scheme provides total accommodation of 19,392 sq m (208,729 sq ft). Anchored by a Tesco Extra supermarket of 10,919 sq m (117,527 sq ft), the centre offers an additional 30 shop units totalling 8,464 sq m (91,102 sq ft), 6 of which are MSU’s including Iceland, Peacocks, Poundland, Boyes, Pep&Co and Home Bargains.

What Three Words

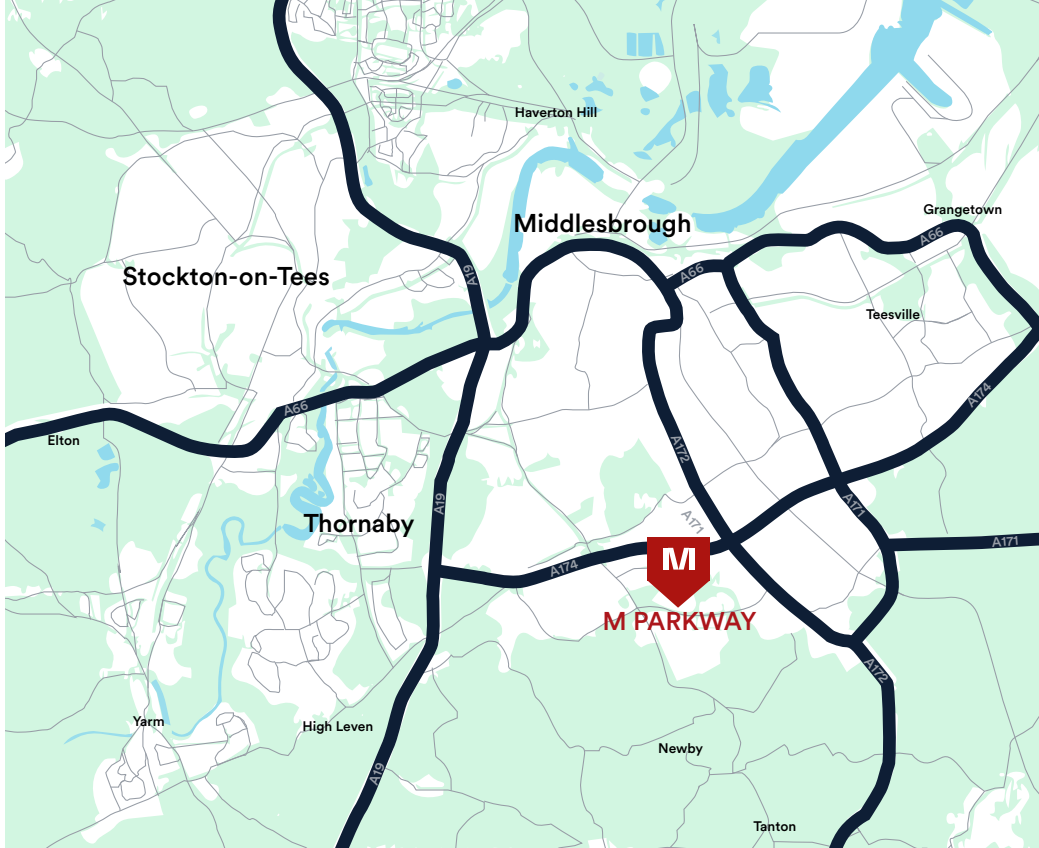
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LOCATION

Middlesbrough is one of the largest towns in the North East, situated close to the A19 and A66 corridors approximately 40 miles south of Newcastle. The town benefits from direct rail services to Manchester Airport (approximately 2 hours 30 minutes), Leeds (75 minutes) and Darlington (35 minutes), making it a well-connected regional centre.

The town's catchment draws from a broad urban and suburban hinterland across Teesside, including surrounding towns and villages that rely on Middlesbrough for major retail provision. Middlesbrough has seen ongoing regeneration and investment in recent years, with new residential and commercial development increasing the local population and driving demand for retail services.

Parkway Shopping Centre sits in the heart of Coulby Newham, directly accessible from the A174 and A19, with excellent pedestrian connectivity to the surrounding residential areas and local bus services.



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
